## **BOND ISSUE SURVEY**

Response from MRPOA members to our July survey indicates overwhelming and enthusiastic approval of the November Bond Issue proposal. While we received but 60 responses to our eminently unscientific study, a *resounding* 54 were enthusiastically in favor.

The proposal put forth by the Bond Issue Coalition will, if okayed by voters in November, raise \$15 million for the purpose of acquiring land for park, recreation, community center or open space throughout Malibu. Moreover, the Bond Issue and its proceeds will make Malibu eligible to apply for and receive grants of additional funding from state, federal an private foundation sources, thus helping to limit commercial development and related traffic congestion.
