ROAD STUFF

We're sure it's not news to anyone, given the ever-present reminders in the form of our ugly plastic containers, that our trash problems continue.

Despite meetings, phone calls and correspondence during the past few years, the level of frustration among Malibu Road Association Board Members – and road

residents – over our inability to deal with this unsightly mess only grows with time.

Your association has, for instance, repeatedly asked that the City of Malibu require – as a condition of <u>every</u> construction or remodeling permit it issues – that requires suitable enclosure(s) be built to hide these eyesores. To our knowledge, this has not happened.

Similarly, we have repeatedly requested help from the County and from the current contractor, *Waste Management (GI Industries)*, with regard to such matters as modifying the waste pickup schedule, providing us with a list of contractors who might build enclosures, and about valet service.

Nothing happens. Nothing changes.

This trash collection system, which was conceived primarily – and understandably – as a way for trash contracting companies to avoid huge insurance costs and liabilities for injuries incurred by workmen who formerly had to lift heavy containers, solved the contractors' problems. But it has resulted in the present situation, which does not appear to be going away. And now, any progress that might have occurred is further slowed by the approaching contract expiration: July 2008. That, at least, is the excuse being offered for allowing the status quo.

As that date approaches, your Malibu Road Association will be taking an active part in specifying – and demanding – services that will accommodate our needs rather than just those of the contracting corporation that takes over the job. To that end, we will be inviting your input.

And meanwhile, we will continue to do whatever we can to incrementally alleviate problems.
